John 18

1. He is a King who can never be a victim. (1-11)
2. He is a King who protects His own. (8)
3. He is a King who bears witness to the truth. (33-40)

**Questions for Discussion/Reflection:**

1. What stood out to you from the sermon/text?
2. Can you think of some implications for your life of the fact that Jesus is a King who can never be a victim?
3. How have you experienced the protection Jesus provides for His own?
4. Have you had times when you didn't feel Jesus protected you? How have you navigated this challenging situation? Does the idea that He eternally protects when He may choose to not protect us here and now seem cruel or meaningful or dismissive of life's real pain?
5. Jesus said He came to bear witness to the truth. How has He revealed truth to you when you couldn't see it at first?
