Losing Your Life to Gain Christ

1. What stood out to you from this passage and the sermon?
2. Looking at Paul's description of his life before knowing Christ, what do you think it cost him to follow Jesus?
3. What costs have you paid to follow Jesus?
4. If someone asked you, "why is knowing Christ so valuable?" how would you respond to them?
5. Can you think of a time when Christ was clearly first in your affections? Can you think of a time when He clearly wasn't? What made the difference between those two times?
6. Knowing Christ is an ongoing relational endeavor. What is something He has been showing you about Himself during these last few months? What has been your response to His showing you this?
