The Generosity of a Christ-Centered Life	

A Christ centered life leads to great generosity.

Here are 5 truths that help us become people of great generosity:

- 1. Great generosity shows people they aren't alone in God's work. (10, 14-16)
- 2. Great generosity isn't driven by people's needs. (11-13)
- 3. Great generosity is self-interested. (17)
- 4. Great generosity is worship. (18)
- 5. Great generosity is a demonstration of faith. (19)
