3. Do you notice any patterns in how you deal with these emotions/mindsets?
4. How might you change your approach to dealing with them so that God is more central to the process? Does the resurrection inform this strategy in any way?
5. How do you react when others are dealing with grief, fear, or doubt? How can we reflect Christ's approach to Mary, the Disciples, and Thomas with each other?
6. Take time as a group to pray and thank God for Jesus' death and resurrection. Thank Him for as many of the benefits of this work as you can think of.
