Questions for Discussion/Reflection

1. When you think of people that you interact with, would they say you value them for what they can do for you or their inherent value? Why?
2. Think about how you value others. What are some ways that you might need others to help you “grow” in viewing the inherent value of people? Are there habits that you can form to hold each other accountable to live differently?
3. Think about how you are valued. Where do you find your value now? If not in the cross, what verse (below) can you memorize this week to remind you that your value to God is secure? Why that verse? *Genesis 1:26-27, 31; Psalm 139:13-14; John 3:16-17; Romans 5:8; John 1:12-13; Ephesians 5:1; 2 Cor 6:18.*
4. Share a story about how you were “crowned” by someone in a way that reminded you to grow into that trait. Who was that person and have you thanked him/her?
5. In your life group or with your family this week, share how you see the image of God in each other. Share the name of someone you want to commend for an “image-of-God trait” you see in him/her (even though that person may not know the Lord yet.)
