**The Amazing Power of Grace Over Sin** | Trent Thompson

Romans 7:7-12

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**Here are 4 truths about the power of God's grace:**

Grace makes it possible to face hard truths about ourselves. (7, 12)

Grace is stronger than sin's corrupting power. (8)

Grace is stronger than sin's multiplying power. (8-9)

Grace is stronger than sin's deceptive power. (10-11)

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## Applying God's Word

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1. Where has God given you an experience of His grace this week? Where has He given it to someone else through you?
2. Read Romans 7:7-12. Why do you think Paul is so intent on defending the law after speaking so negatively about it in chapters 2-6?
3. How does Paul's defense of the law and its relationship to sin serve to illuminate the greatness of God's grace?
4. How have you seen your sin nature use a good thing for bad purposes?
5. How have you seen your sinful desires grow when you were told something was sinful?
6. Have you ever believed you were fully obeying God's command only to find out you weren't later? What was that experience like?
7. How have you seen God's grace change the way you relate to His commands?

### Memory Verse: Romans 7:7

*What then shall we say? That the law is sin? By no means! Yet if it had not been for the law, I would not have known sin. For I would not have known what it is to covet if the law had not said, "You shall not covet."*

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
