- **Be bold: (v.15)**
- **Treat disciple-making as a gift of grace: (v.16)**
- **Think of disciple-making as an offering: (v.16)**
- **Dream bigger than getting into heaven: (v.16-18)**
- **Trust the Spirit: (v. 16, 19)**
- **Apply the cross: (v.21)**
- **Complete the work God gives you: (v.19)**
